**Subject:** Homicide Investigation Update

On October 1, 2021, at approximately 12:50 PM, the Brown County Sheriff's Office received a report of a fight involving knives/guns at 243 Schlitz Drive in Lake Lorelei located near Fayetteville, Ohio. Units responding to that location found a white male, later identified as Timothy Vogel, date of birth of 06/21/1989 in the home with a gunshot wound to the chest. Emergency medical personnel responded to the scene and commenced life saving measures but Mr. Vogel died prior to transport.

Initial investigation revealed that Mr. Vogel was in an altercation with Jason Metcalfe, date of birth of 11/4/1979, who resides at 243 Schlitz Drive. Jason Metcalfe drew a pistol and shot Timothy Vogel in the chest. Jason Metcalfe immediately fled the scene and stole a 2016 White CHEV pick-up truck bearing Ohio license HWF-2481. Jason Metcalfe was last seen leaving Lake Lorelei and traveling west on State Route 131.

Suspect Jason Metcalfe was observed operating the white CHEV truck bearing Ohio license plate HWF-2481 in the vicinity of Lake Lorelei at approximately 8:44 PM. Police units from Fayetteville Police Department, the Ohio State Highway Patrol and Brown County Sheriff's Office attempted to stop the suspect vehicle which fled and proceeded through several counties before being stopped in Clinton County by a Clinton County Sheriff's Office marked unit in the vicinity of State Route 134 and State Route 28. Information concerning the outcome of the pursuit will be released by the Clinton County Sheriff's Office.
