The Aberdeen Police Department received a call advising of a possible submerged vehicle in the Ohio River in the area of the Aberdeen Public Boat Ramp.

On June 12, 2019 the Aberdeen Police Department responded to the public boat ramp with assistance from the Brown County Sheriff's Office and members of Task Force 1 to attempt to locate the vehicle. Once on scene Task Force 1 located and removed two vehicles from the Ohio River near the public boat ramp.

Upon investigating the vehicles it was determined that one of the vehicles that was removed contained possible human remains. The vehicle was removed from the scene and the case is currently under a joint investigation.
